"The finest movies of the frail, sensitive little Arshinkov were written by those princes of Bulgarian scenarists, the "brothers Mormarev" – not brothers at all, in fact, but old friends and collaborators (Marko Storychev and Moritz Yomkov) whose delectable but different senses of humour have combined to produce some of the world's subtlest and funniest scripts for

children. Their tales ("HEDGE-HOGS", "CHILDREN AT THE SEASIDE") are moral in the best sense, with lessons learnt through laughter, not preaching.

In "THE WIND OF TRAVEL" Ivan played a little peasant boy who one day bids farewell to the buffalo he tends, and sets out alone to discover the world and what it means to be a

man. **"MEMORY"** pitted him against a piano
and a piano-teacher."
