Cut off in his prime as Macduff's son in Polanski's "**MACBETH**" – "Thou lie'st, thou shag-eared villain!", "What? You egg! Young fry of treachery!", "He has killed me, mother!" – Mark nose-dived into the title role of a CFF production directed, as few of them were, by a professional film-maker of some repute (Michael Powell): "**THE BOY WHO TURNED YELLOW**". Most of the stills here, however, are from a later French-made film, "**IMPOSSIBLE OBJECT**", (aka: "The Story of a Love Story") which was shelved. It's not known what became of him in adult life.
