The Moving Picture Boy entry:

““The pleasant, sandy-haired Eccles had his only starring part – as a 13-year old botanist on a self-imposed survival course – in **"MY SIDE OF THE MOUNTAIN"**. Though Jean George's novel hardly lent itself to drama, Teddy Eccles made a resolute figure of the junior Thoreau.

He had in fact already had several years in films (his first commercial feature was at two

months), and caught the eye as the bottle-collecting boy of **"IN COLD BLOOD"**. He was often to be seen on TV. After twenty years in films and TV, Ted Eccles left the acting business. (A "dying role" in **"General Hospital"** seemed a fitting exit.)

Instead he turned to the craft of special effects, then trailers and music videos. After working in turn for Paramount and Disney, he went into a partnership in 1986 to make promotional videos for new films.”
