The Moving Picture Boy entry:

"This sad-eyed child was already popular in France before becoming the second French boy in three years to be flown across the Atlantic to the bosom of Bing Crosby – who this time, in **"LITTLE BOY LOST"**, was searching for his own son rather than a potential adoptee. Prophetically, Christian had been in **"VOYAGE EN AMÉRIQUE"** the year before. He enjoyed Hollywood, but admitted to an occasional longing for a dish of snails.

In **"BRELAN D'AS"**, a portmanteau film, he was in the episode *"A Choirboy's Evidence"*. Later he was to play some of the classic

French boy-roles, such as Le Souris in **"CRAINQUEBILLE"**, Gavroche in **"LES MISÉRABLES"**, and Rémi in **"SANS FAMILLE"**.

After 1957, Fourcade's acting career continued for another decade or so. He was in **"PAR-DESSUS LE MUR"** (59), **"LE CAPITAN"** (60) and many more. But their importance dwindled, to him at least. By the early Seventies he was running a stud-farm in Rambouillet."
