The Moving Picture Boy entry:

"This whimsical mouse, a lawyer's son, rapidly became a Bulgarian favourite in his early films. Two of them - **"CHILDREN PLAYING"** and **"EXAMS"** - were directed by Ivanka Grubcheva: delightful episodic affairs in which Dimiter's droll expressions and attitudes were prominent. In **"HOUSES WITHOUT FENCES"** he is an orphan cared for, with varying success, by a succession of friends and neighbours before being entrusted to a children's home. His innocent frankness [sic] at once disconcerts and disarms. He also had a lead in **"The Hedgehogs' War"**, a TV serial of the mid-1970s which was released several years later in condensed cinema form."
