"Charles Herbert Saperstein was a square-faced little boy with some droll expressions and tones of voice, good value in films of the late Fifties. He made his bow in 1953 on TV's **"Half-Pint Panel"**, and was later active on the stage, where he earned an Emmy nomination for his performance as a blind child in a play called "The Miracle Hour". After 1960 Charles Herbert made one or two more appearances in TV series like **"The Twilight Zone"** and **"The Outer Limits"**, but not much more."
