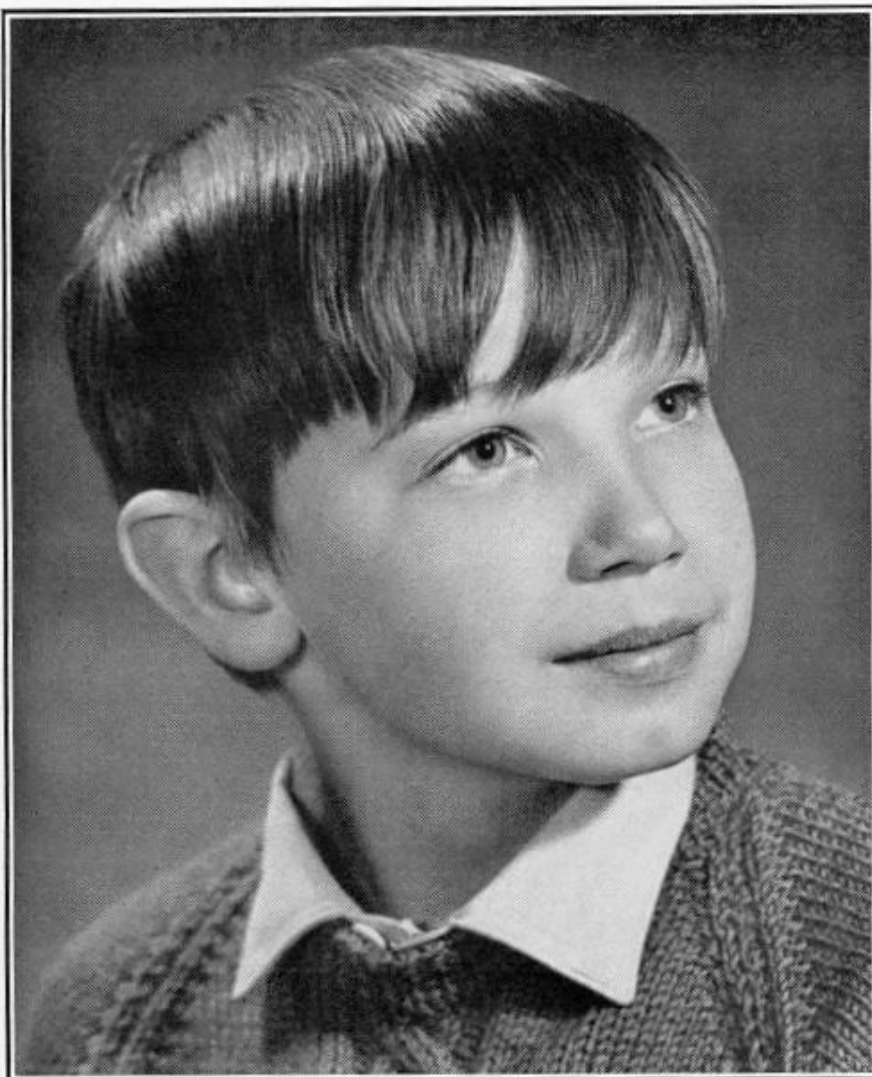


Len Jones

Cheeky-faced Northern boy who played Len (14) the youngest member of James Mason's family in "**SPRING AND PORT WINE**" following extensive theatre, radio and TV work and several Children's Film Foundation titles. He had a small role in the unpleasant "**STRAW DOGS**" as a village boy whose flighty young sister is throttled by a simpleton, precipitating the siege of Dustin Hoffman's and Susan George's farmhouse. Nothing else is known about him. He's not listed in *The Moving Picture Boy*.
