Twins who had a modest, all but invisible, role in one of Elvis Presley's lame happy-go-lucky vehicles. Presley plays the slow-witted son of a hillbilly family who decide to claim "homesteader rights" on a stretch of virgin Florida beach. The twins are distant cousins unofficially adopted by Presley's pa, while the two girls are no relation at all. Presley has a few insipid numbers in the film but, despite this publicity shot, the boys do not sing along, and remain off-camera for the greater part of the action. They have a piece of schtick involving sharing a candy bar – one twin breaks it into uneven halves, then bites off the difference to make them equal. Near the end of the film the other twin plays the same trick back on him. Nothing else is known of them. They're not listed in *The Moving Picture Boy*.
