The Moving Picture Boy entry:

"Jacques Moulière (as he was born) was a dark, fierce, sensitive boy who contributed memorably to French films of the Fifties. In streetwise or gypsyish parts he was matchless.

After 1959 he appeared in at least one more feature film, "**UN CLAIR DE LUNE À MAUBEUGE**" (62). But Jacky Moulière – he

reverted to his authentic name – now turned himself into a pop singer, making records as well as performing in live concerts and broadcasting."
