As Kevin, an impossibly cute English prep school type with a lazy “R” (“Wandall”, “Wobin Hood” etc) he is swept off by dwarf brigands on a whirlwind tour of the Great Men of History in Terry Gilliam’s beguiling fantasy **“TIME BANDITS”**, hitting it off famously with King Agamemnon, but having his name taken by god for unitdiness. Surrounded by six squabbling dwarfs, Kevin is not only the most sensible and shrewd member of the gang, he’s also head and shoulders the tallest, and Gilliam uses this unusual perspective to good effect, drawing the young boy more immediately into the action around him. Warnock is appealing and natural as the stifled suburban English boy catapulted into a far richer world. Nothing else is known of him, or the second film he made two years later.
