Norway 1999: Girl (10) mourning her little brother's death from cancer is sent to her grandparents where she meets a boy and heals. With *Thea Sofie Rusten* and *Jan Torre Kristoffersen*.

Belgium 1999: Episodic tales of a boy (*Joren Seldeslacht*, +/-13) one summer, including the death of his pet dog.

Hungary / US 1969: Remake of classic boys' wargame melodrama by Ferenc Molnar, with *Anthony Kemp*, *John Moulder Brown*, *Martin Beaumont* etc

US 1977: Girl, 11, recruits cannibal zombies from the local cemetery to help her avenge the death of her mother, with *Rosalie Cole*.

US 1912: "Thanouser Kid" *Marie Eline*, 10, having expired of poor factory working conditions, is seen returning to console her parents in angel's garb.

US 1960: From a Pulitzer Prize-winning play based on the author's memoirs of a boyhood in 1920s Oklahoma. One of the plot strands concerns his (*Robert Eyer*) awakening sexuality. Another concerns a Jewish boy (*Lee Kinsolving*) driven to suicide by anti-semitism.

UK? 1989: Peter Greenaway short on two 18th century Paris anatomists who made a study of the corpses dredged from the Seine, many of them children.

Poland 2001: Jewish boy, 11, (*Haley Joel Osment*) evades the Warsaw Ghetto during WW2 by hiding out in a rural village where "the kids create a ritualistic game with the hope of resurrecting the dead".
